In September 1902 the Arctic whaling vessel *Nova Zembla* struck a reef off Baffin Island and sank fast. Using first-hand accounts and other historical clues Dr. Michael Moloney and Dr. Matthew Ayre, research fellows at the Arctic Institute of North America, UCalgary, found the remains of the wreck and will take you through their fascinating investigation.
